

## **Code of Conduct Disclosure**

Bloomberg Finance L.P. and its affiliates including Bloomberg L.P. Bloomberg employees are subject to a code of conduct prohibiting the misuse of confidential information and the use or dissemination of non-public information that would be considered material by a reasonable person in deciding whether or not to buy, sell or hold a particular financial instrument. Employees involved with the Valuation/Research Products may hold positions in the financial instruments analyzed by such products but Bloomberg has adopted policies on employee interests and personal account dealing designed to ensure that employees involved with the Valuation/Research Products are not likely to be in situations where conflicts of interest arise.
